He begins the process with priming the surface black then using an impressionist palette to create each piece. Ken believes in making truly one-of-a-kind works and is the sole creator of every piece.

Attendees enjoy making an entire day of the festival; they start by walking throughout the event and viewing the works of 125 nationally acclaimed, award-winning artists from throughout the country and abroad, as they stroll they can partake in unparalleled wine and micro-brew tasting, as well as spirit sampling. Live music can be heard throughout the festival and come lunch-time a variety of food trucks are on site. The festival also has delectable fudge, fresh-baked cookies, kettle corn, ice cream and more, to satisfy that sweet tooth. "One of the world's tallest fountains" can also be seen



throughout the day. At full power, the fountain rises 560 feet into the air and runs for approximately 15 minutes at the top of the hour, from 10a.m. to 9p.m. daily. The town has a variety of delicious restaurants and cafés to end the day on a perfect note.
