This winter, Thunderbird Artists brings the indoors outdoors, with Surprise Fine Art & Wine Festival, on January 7th, 8th, and 9th—our 10th year in downtown Surprise

Thunderbird Artists, the leading producer of fine art events in the southwest, is thrilled to present the Thunderbird Artists Fine Art & Wine Festival, held for the tenth year in Surprise. As with all Thunderbird Artists events, guests can view fine art selected through a comprehensive jury process, sample fine wines and spirits, snack on festival food, and listen to live music, all while enjoying the sunshine and meeting fellow art lovers.

Art:

Known in the art world as ‘...a Collectors’ Paradise,’TM Thunderbird Artists prides itself on quality and diversity. The festival boasts over 85 juried artists exhibiting a wide range of oils, acrylics, pastels, watercolors, gouache, original and limited-edition photography, as well as ink, pencil, and charcoal drawings. Collectors with more surfaces than empty walls can take home sculpture in stone, bronze, metal, hand-blown glass, wood, clay, and gourds. And for those who wear their art collections, Thunderbird Artists festivals offer a broad range of one-of-a-kind jewelry. This year’s featured artist is Ken Ferguson, a 21st century watercolor and gouache artist with a 19th century heart (see page 3 and his pictures throughout).

Wine and Spirits:

Combining world-class fine art with an extensive selection of domestic and imported wines has long been Thunderbird Artists’ winning formula. This year’s participating wineries include Cellar 433, Schlossadler, King Frosch, and Mediterranean Table, as well as Desert Diamond Distillery for whiskey, vodka, and rum. For an additional fee, patrons receive an engraved souvenir glass with tasting tickets; unlike festivals with designated drinking areas, Thunderbird Artists events have patrons wandering at will, sipping wine and immersing themselves in phenomenal art.

For four decades and over 400 events, Thunderbird Artists has launched artists’ careers, united nationally recognized artists with international collectors and helped elevate the southwest art scene to one of global admiration and respect. 

Thunderbird Artists’ Festival’s Featured Artist for Surprise: Watercolor and Gouache Painter Ken Ferguson

A twenty-first century artist with a nineteenth-century heart, watercolor and gouache artist Ken Ferguson sees history through a modern lens, rendering nature, animals, and classic old-west figures in clean contemporary lines and rich color. Although he traces his fascination with historical military culture to a childhood viewing of the 1964 film *Zulu*, Ken’s passion extends to the natural world, and he brings his varied subjects alive with vivid detail. He’s spent a lifetime as a working artist, navigating changing tastes and economic challenges, but still follows a simple truth: “I paint what I like and try to sell it instead of painting what sells and trying to like it.”



Ken counts Thunderbird Artists festivals among the best show experiences in his 40-year career. “They’re well juried, well thought-out, and well attended,” he says. “There’s a lively atmosphere, and because they’re only three days long, the people attending are present and focused. And the wine loosens everyone up.” He also loves the promoter-artist camaraderie. “Some shows, after you set up, you’re on your own,” he says. “But Judi and Denise are at every Thunderbird Artists show, and one or both will make sure they stop by every artist’s booth to check in and see how you’re doing. As an artist, you get a lot of support.”
