She wrote and completed her debut album Rosin Revolver Vol. 1, which was released this past December.

Also performing at the festival will be guitarist, Scott Helmer. Scott is a master of reinvention and like his music – an inspiration. His contagious, radio-friendly blend of rock and pop infuses memorable guitar riffs, catchy sing-along choruses and lyrics that tell real stories. These songs, co-written and recorded with his talented photographer/musician

brother, Rich Helmer, have also crossed over to fans of Country & Americana, where solid songwriting and storytelling are so highly valued.

The festival also hosts one of the largest wine tasting events in the Southwest. For \$10, patrons will receive an engraved souvenir wine glass and tasting tickets, providing a unique opportunity to sample an extensive collection of domestic and imported wines.
